



In order to submit a dissertation in <https://epub.uni-luebeck.de/> an application for admission to the doctoral procedure or doctorate to the doctoral office of your section is necessary.

1. Registration

If you haven't already done so, you first need to register on ePub by entering an email address.

We recommend that you use the e-mail address from the above-mentioned application for admission.

You will then receive a confirmation email from our system, which will take you to a form for further information, where you can enter the following:

- Your **name**
- Your **self-chosen password**
- Your preferred system language

Your information will then be transmitted to your responsible doctoral office, where it will be checked. Usually, your account then will be activated for publication in your section.



2. Submission under "My ePub"



As soon as your account has been approved for publication, a black bar with a **Plus** or

"**+ New**" at the top left edge of your browser window appears. Here you can submit your dissertation under Medium.



Select your section (usually only the section in which you are doing your doctorate is approved).

Following, further information on your submission and on publication permission is collected.

An overview you find on the 2nd page.

We publish **PDF** files:



1. **With max. 512 MB (web-optimized, we recommend max. 256 MB)**
2. **No DRM restriction (copy/print/password protection)**
3. **Without personal curriculum vitae (CV) or contact details**
4. **Your form details must match the data in the PDF**

Repeatable information (see table column "Repeat")

[+ Add more](#) allows you to enter multiple details

During or after the filling in process, you have the following options:



Completely removes your previously entered information
i.e. no further processing is possible



Saves your previously entered information and leaves the input window open
This also happens automatically every few minutes as you type



Saves your information and closes the input mask



If all mandatory information is complete, send your publication to the library for formality check. "See " During the formal examination, no further correction of the information is possible.

Important: Check your mails

- A) The formal check has been passed and your file has been published (Publication)
Your doctoral office will be informed about your successful publication via newsletter.
- B) Your PDF file or Your information is incorrect or does not match (rejection)
Under "My Dspace" (link see mail) you can exchange your details and files again if necessary and submit them again in a corrected form.

Note: the URN citation link of your publication is usually provisional and only effective after approx. 3 weeks.
